It is considered the finest example of Rajput architecture whose lattice like exterior of sandstone and stained glass is one of the area's most eye-catching icons.

We will continue to the 16th-century Amber Fort. Tour the chambers and hallways of the palace. Within the complex is Ganesh Pol, an imposing gateway painted with the images of the elephant-headed god, Ganesh. The merging of Rajput and Mughal architectural styles is visible throughout, including within the Charbagh garden with its perfectly proportioned landscaping.
