As the second smallest hotel in the Leading Hotels of the World, it is close to the exquisite cliffs of Telašćica Nature Park, the beautiful islands of Kornati National Park, and Zadar, which boasts some of the most stunning sunsets on the Adriatic.

After our cultural exploration, we indulge in a delightful wine tasting and lunch at Chateau Mukhrani or Guramishvili's Winery, featuring Khinkali dumplings and a Churchkhela sweet-making masterclass.

Continuing our adventure, we dedicate a full day to exploring Tbilisi's rich history, vibrant culture, and captivating architecture. In the Old Town, we stroll through cobbled streets, marveling at iconic Georgian houses and the ancient Anchiskhati Basilica, before ascending Narikala Fortress for a panoramic view. After lunch, choose between an optional visit to the National Museum of Georgia or leisure time before our evening farewell dinner atop Mtatsminda hill, where fine Georgian wines accompany our meal.
