Set out on an enthralling adventure as we pilot our way to Colombia, a nation renowned for its rich ethnic dersity. Our destination is Cartagena, an enchanting city suspended in time between the 16th and 19th centuries, with the Caribbean Sea as its backdrop. This UNESCO World Heritage Site boasts well-preserved colonial architecture, offering a walking city experience with restored mansions, horse-drawn carriages, and old-world style plazas.

The following day, guided by a local expert, we will embark on a walking tour of the historic walled old town. Uncover the hidden history of Cartagena as we visit iconic landmarks such as Puerta Del Reloj, Plaza San Pedro Claver with its stunning Church, and Plaza Bolivar. After lunch, our adventure continues with a drive to the impressive Castillo San Felipe, the largest Spanish fortification in the Americas, built in the 17th century. Our tour concludes with a visit to the 17th-century Convent of La Popa, perched atop the city's highest point, offering breathtaking views of the bay, Old Town, and the Caribbean Sea beyond.

This strategic pause allows us to acclimate to the unique charms of the Galapagos, ensuring we're fully refreshed and ready for the extraordinary experiences that await.

CHARTER FLIGHT

Embark on an unforgettable adventure aboard the Cormorant II yacht. After a short charter flight to Baltra we will be greeted by a Cormorant II staff member and transferred to the yacht. Settle in, enjoy lunch, and partake in a welcome briefing together.

On day one, we will explore Bachas Beach, immersed in WWII history and bustling with wildlife such as flamingos, sea turtles, and crabs. Day two invites us to visit El Barranco for breathtaking views and encounters with unique bird species, followed by a leisurely stroll along the white sand coral beach of Darwin Bay. Day three offers the chance to discover a small island with steep cliffs and vibrant flora and fauna, followed by a journey to Santa Fe Island for its picturesque bays and scenic trails. On day four, we will indulge in birdwatching at Pitt Point and unwind on a picturesque beach on San Cristobal Island.

We conclude our adventure on day five at the Breeding Center David Rodriguez, where giant tortoises roam freely in a protected sanctuary, before heading to San Cristobal airport to retrieve our airplanes for our flight to Panama.





Cormorant II

The Cormorant II is the largest luxury catamaran in the Galapagos. Accommodating a total of 16 guests, this vessel features nine spacious, elegantly designed suites providing a pleasant and comfortable stay.

In each modern suite aboard the Cormorant II, guests will find floor-to-ceiling, panoramic windows and private balconies. The Premium Suites include an oversized balcony with an exclusive jacuzzi. The main deck features two pairs of connected cabins, which are the perfect option for families or groups.

An attentive crew will keep an eye on every detail, providing an intimate cruising experience through the Galapagos Islands during the entire itinerary.


